

APA Style Manual, 7th Edition—*Overview of changes*

- The running head is *no longer required* for student papers
- The title page now requires more information and should be centered:

Title of essay in bold (3-4 spaces down from top of page)

Student's name

Department, University or College title

Class number: Title of class

Professor's name

Due date of assignment

- **Abstract** and **References** headings in bold
- **Title of essay in bold**
- Option of fonts include the following: Calibri 11, Arial 11, Lucida Sans Unicode 10, Times New Roman 12, and Georgia 11
- In-text citations of three or more authors: include only the first author's name and "et al."
- Use of singular "they" is endorsed
- Only one space is required after a period
- Surnames of up to 20 authors (instead of seven) should be included in references
- The label DOI is no longer necessary. However, links should be included and underlined:

- URLs are no longer preceded by "Retrieved from," unless source content is updated over time
- The publisher location is no longer included
