

BUSINESS LAW

BLW 240 BUSINESS LAW I

(formerly BUS 140 and BUS 240)

This course provides a general survey of the ethical considerations and legal environment used to make business decisions. Students examine business implications of Constitutional Law, Tort Law, Criminal Law, Intellectual Property Law, Internet Law and Privacy Law. Students study the law of contracts including formation, enforceability and available remedies upon breach. An overview of business organizations including formation, dissolution and a comparison of the liability, taxation and management properties of each is covered. **3 credits**

BLW 241 BUSINESS LAW II

(formerly BUS 141 and BUS 241)

This course is a continuation of Business Law I with an emphasis on the Uniform Commercial Code. Topics covered include Domestic and International Sales and Lease Contracts, Negotiable instruments and the banking system, Insurance, Real Property, Personal Property and Wills Trusts and Estates. This second course of a two-course sequence covers all Business Law CPA Exam subject matter. Prerequisite: BLW 240. **3 credits**
