The following requirements and reimbursements apply for all graduate assistants:*

must be a graduate student enrolled in a minimum of 6 graduate credits during the semester(s) of the assistantship
must work 10 hours per week or the equivalent for a total of 150 hours over the course of the semester
will receive a 3-credit voucher per semester
will receive a \$500.00 stipend per semester
maximum number of four assistantship semesters are allowed per student

**Students receiving full or partial tuition remission or are employed by Molloy College (full or part-time) are not eligible for assistantships.*

Applications must include two personal references and approval by the department in which the student is enrolled. Applications and appropriate documentation are to be returned to the Office of Graduate Academic Affairs. Each applicant selected as a graduate assistantship recipient must be enrolled in the College upon commencement of the position. Applications will be forwarded to the appropriate College Departments and applicants will be interviewed by the Graduate Assistantship Supervisor.
