NCC students take 8 credits of Music Theory in total at NCC. Molloy music education majors take 14 credits of Music Theory in total at Molloy. If NCC student successfully completes NCC's 8 credits of Music Theory with a grade of $\mathrm{C}+$ or higher, these 8 credits will be applied to the following Molloy University Music Theory courses: MUS 1010 Theory Fundamentals ( 2 cr.), MUS 1120 Harmony I ( 3 cr.), MUS 2130 Harmony II ( 3 cr.). This accounts for the closest alignment of coursework and levels among the two institutions. This means NCC students will still be required to take MUS 3140 Harmony III ( 3 cr .) and MUS 1160 Form and Analysis ( 3 cr .) at Molloy.
\# Regarding NCC's Music History Elective(s), Molloy will apply the credits to the equivalent Music History Course(s) that best match the scope and content of the corresponding Molloy course. Due to NASSM requirements, it is essential that Music majors complete 9 credits in Music History covering Western music spanning the middle ages through the present. Accordingly, we urge NCC to encourage their students to opt for NCC Music History Courses that we could apply toward the required ones: NCC 201 for Molloy MUS 1990, NCC 204 for Molloy MUS 2000, NCC 208 for Molloy MUS 2030.
** The Total Remaining Credits speculates that the college admissions will waive FST, and that GEN ED courses taken meet threshold for GEN ED requirements related to the Music Ed program, which is outside the Music Department's jurisdiction.

Students are required to take Applied Music ( 1 cr .) on their primary instrument or voice, ensemble ( 0.0 cr .), MUS 0101 Concert Attendance ( 0.0 cr .), for every semester. This is necessary to develop a depth of musicianship and sustained engagement with both music and education disciplines throughout their studies.
