\*\*\*Humanities Electives I and II: a) If a philosophy course is selected to fulfill the Humanities Elective I, students can select one of the following to fulfill the Humanities Elective II: philosophy, foreign language, English, communications, art, music, theatre, or any other Humanities course designated "HUM" except HUM130. b) If a foreign language course is selected to fulfill the Humanities Elective I, students must fulfill the Humanities Elective II by selecting either the next higher course in the same foreign language or a philosophy course.

†Liberal arts and sciences electives include most courses in the humanities, natural sciences, mathematics, and social sciences. Performance or studio courses (e.g., drawing, painting, acting, ensembles) are generally not considered liberal arts and sciences.
