Dear Molloy Pioneer,

Being a Pioneer isn't always easy; whether you're walking for months beside a covered wagon or one of the first class of students who took more than 150 college credits in four years. The pioneer experience marks you and leaves an imprint, even 55 years after the experience.

At Molloy College, we want to record your pioneer experiences. At the celebration of your 55th anniversary, a group of your former classmates discussed pooling together each person's "cameo" of remembrances about the early days of the college. A cameo is "a short descriptive sketch that neatly encapsulates someone or something." Our goal is to collect these stories and make them part of the official history of Molloy College that will be housed in Archives. The cameos will be available to future researchers and historians as primary source documents. Once all the information is collected, Molloy will make recommendations to the class about how to best exhibit this information. Some ideas discussed in October include a legacy wall plaque, a video display monitor in a kiosk, or a documentary.
