TRANSFER CREDITS

PT stands for ‘Pending Transfer’. Your H.S. does not send AP score reports or College Transcripts **

AP Credit:

- 1. Check your transcript for AP CREDIT**
- 2. If there are AP CREDITS listed, did you?**
 - A. Take the AP Exam?
 - B. Earn a 3 or better on the exam?
- 3. Are there AP credits you took in HS that are NOT indicated on your transcript?**
 - A. Go to [Collegeboard.org](https://collegeboard.org) and send the Official Score Report to Molloy Admissions.
 - B. Check status with the Student Solution Center 2 weeks after

COLLEGE Credit:

- 1. Check your transcript for COLLEGE CREDIT**
- 2. If there are COLLEGE CREDITS listed, did you?**
 - A. Pay for the credits?
 - B. Complete the course with a C or better?
 - C. Send an Official Transcript from the college or university through which you earned the credits?
- 3. Are there COLLEGE credits you took in HS that are NOT indicated on your transcript?**
 - A. Request on official transcript from the College or University through which you earned the credits and have it sent to Molloy Admissions
 - B. Check status with the Student Solution Center 2 weeks after

COMPONENTS OF YOUR SCHEDULE

Your first semester schedule is a combination of classes required for the degree you are currently pursuing and consists of the following:

FST 1000 - A participative exploration of the fundamentals of college life and the requirements a student is expected to meet in order to complete successfully the first year of studies. Students who do not pass this course must repeat it.

General Education courses: Listed on the left-side of your degree Status Sheet, Gen Ed requirements provide students not only with knowledge of the subject, but also with the essential skills in writing, communication, research and critical thinking necessary to demonstrate an understanding of the interrelatedness between disciplines. These are courses that all students at Molloy are required to take, regardless of their major.

Related Requirements: Courses required for your degree but not specifically within your major.

Major Requirements: These are the courses required for your major as recommended by the major department.

AP Score reports from Collegeboard.org and Official Transcripts from the University that awarded the credit must be sent to Admissions as soon as possible.

IMPORTANT REMINDERS FOR NURSING STUDENTS

- For progression purposes, it is strongly recommended that students take 17 credits their first semester. This is 1 credit over what is included in tuition and an overload charge for the additional credit will be added to your bill.
- General Psychology (PSY 1100) is required your first semester. Not doing so will impact your progression. If you did not receive an AP score of 3 or above or paid for college credit and received a C or better, you will need to take it in the fall.
- You cannot split up science lectures from lab. They are linked together.
- AP Biology and Chemistry does not satisfy the science requirement for the Nursing program.
- If you have an RQ listed on your transcript, please make sure to discuss this with an SSC advisor.
- If you are going to be a student athlete at Molloy, a resident student, or plan to register with the Center for Access and Disability, please let an SSC advisor know.
