Skill Testing:

- Skill testing is **only** conducted at the Rockville Centre campus, no skill testing is done at the Suffolk campus.
- On the day of testing, students may not ask for assistance from a nursing instructor or peer mentor. It is the student's responsibility to bring an adult partner for any skill requiring a partner.
- If an unsuccessful skill test occurs, the student is made immediately aware by the lab instructor and is remediated on the skill. Students may **NOT** re-test that day. A student may be tested a second time with a different lab instructor on a different day. If the student is unsuccessful after the second test, the lab instructor will notify the lecture professor for subsequent testing protocol.

Equipment and Supplies:

- Clean and return all equipment/supplies and report any equipment issues.
- Equipment maybe borrowed for community use, contact the CLC to make a request.

- The CLC reserves the right to adjust the schedule based on evolving circumstances.
- No food/beverages, children, cell phones, videotaping (unless pre-approved) permitted.
- Uniforms are not permitted in the CLC when coming from a clinical environment.
