

Health Services- FAQ COVID- 19

1. I have been exposed to someone who tested positive for COVID-19. Do I have to quarantine?

Individuals who are not fully vaccinated and are identified as a close contact are required to quarantine. **Fully vaccinated** individuals who are identified as a close contact and are **asymptomatic** do not need to quarantine.

2. I am fully vaccinated and I have been identified as a close contact and I am experiencing symptoms. What do I do?

Fully vaccinated individuals who have been identified as a close contact and become symptomatic **MUST** isolate, obtain a PCR test and notify Health Services at COVID19@molloy.edu

3. How will I know if I am considered to be a close contact who has to quarantine?

A nurse from Health Services will reach out to you by phone. If they are unable to reach you by phone, they will send you an email.

4. What should I do if I test positive for COVID-19?

If you test positive for COVID19 you should immediately isolate, and notify Health Services at COVID19@molloy.edu You should also complete the COVID Infection and Exposure Form located in the secure Molloy Health Portal at www.molloy.studenthealthportal.com

5. Am I considered a close contact if I am wearing a mask?

Yes, you are still considered a close contact even if you were wearing a mask while you were around someone with COVID-19. Masks are meant to protect other people in case you are infected, and not to protect you from being infected.

6. What if I have been around someone who was identified as a close contact?

If you have been around someone who was identified as a close contact to a person with COVID-19, closely monitor yourself for any symptoms of COVID-19. You do not need to self-quarantine unless you develop symptoms, or if the person identified as a close contact tests positive for COVID-19. Fully vaccinated exposed individuals **DO NOT** have to quarantine unless they become symptomatic.
