## TIPS FOR SUCCESS

**E-MAIL:** You will receive an email to the personal email address we have on file from [noreply@molloy.edu](mailto:noreply@molloy.edu) 72 hours after you register. The email will include a link to set up your Molloy email address. It is important to do this in a timely manner. Faculty, staff and administrators use your Molloy email address to communicate with you regularly. If you have any questions please contact Technology Support Services, Room K022, ext. 4800 or the Information Commons on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor of the Public Square, ext. 4817.

**ID CARDS:** All Students must have a picture ID card, which must be carried while on campus. The ID card is used to borrow books in our Library, to use the Shuttle Service, the Computer Lab and the Fitness Center. You can obtain an ID card from the Public Safety command center which is located in the Maria Regina Annex, Monday-Thursdays 10:00am-12:00pm and 2:00pm-4:00 pm.

**PARKING PERMIT:** All students parking on campus must have a parking permit, which can also be obtained, from the Public Safety command center. They are located in the Maria Regina Annex, Monday-Thursdays 10:00am-12:00pm and 2:00pm-4:00 pm.

**LIONS DEN PORTAL:** Important information regarding registration, bills, and financial aid can be accessed through the Lion's Den found under the **MOLLOY LIFE** tab at the top of the screen or visiting <https://lionsden.molloy.edu/ics>. Your username and password for Lion's Den is the same as your e-mail username and password.

**RAVE EMERGENCY NOTIFICATION SYSTEM:** All students are enrolled automatically for the Molloy College emergency notification system. Should an emergency arise on campus you will be notified via a text message. **HEALTH AND ACCIDENT INSURANCE – SPRING SEMESTER ONLY\***: All full-time undergraduate students are required to carry Health and Accident Insurance. If a student is currently covered by another policy, the Molloy College insurance may be waived by completing an online waiver. Online waivers may be accessed in the “My Finances” tab on the Lion’s Den Student Portal. Students must read and follow all the instructions on the online form. **Waiver forms must be submitted via the web by February 1<sup>st</sup> for the Spring semester.** Waivers submitted past this date **CANNOT** be accepted. New Spring full-time Undergraduate students will be charged a partial rate of \$1,501 for the Health and Accident Insurance. *Health and Accident Insurance must be waived online for each subsequent years of enrollment.*

**GUIDELINES FOR REGISTRATION**: To be eligible to register for future semesters, students must have no holds and a zero balance on their bill. To check your account contact the Bursar’s Office 516.323.4100. From the Molloy homepage [www.molloy.edu](http://www.molloy.edu) click on **Online Faculty and Student Access** to go to your Lion’s Den account to check for any balances or holds on your account. You may not register or add/drop courses until all holds are removed by the office placing the hold. You will need your full student email address (JDoe@lions.molloy.edu) and password to access your records.

Every student is assigned an academic advisor by approximately six weeks into their first semester. Students meet with their advisors at least once a semester to review their progress and to plan their courses for the next semester. Check your online web account for your advisor’s name. Declared majors are assigned advisors by the departmental chairperson or division associate dean. If you have not yet declared a major, your advisor will be assigned by the Associate Dean for Academic Services. Students in the St. Thomas Aquinas Program who are undeclared will be advised by their assigned counselors.

Early registration for Fall 2018 is scheduled for March 6<sup>th</sup> through April 13<sup>th</sup> (see Lion’s Den online web account for “When Do I Register?” or follow announcements on the Molloy College website for your registration date). Students may “reserve” courses for advisor approval during early registration. **It is your responsibility to schedule an appointment with your advisor during the advisement period at the assigned times to get the best schedule.**

During early registration, March 6<sup>th</sup> through April 13<sup>th</sup>, students will reserve courses, and then see their advisor for approval. Students may continue to register/add/drop for on-going registration with advisor clearance after early registration ends. All “reserved” courses, not approved by the advisor will be dropped. See college announcements for details.

The Late Change of Program deadline should be observed if you do not wish to get a grade of “W” or “WF”. After this date a grade of “W” or “WF” is assigned. Refunds are based upon the date you drop or withdraw from courses. Students may not withdraw after the last date to withdraw, which is before Final Exams Week begins.

**SCHOLARSHIPS AND FINANCIAL AID:** You must reapply each year for scholarships and financial aid by filing the FAFSA and TAP application. The FAFSA should be filed as soon as possible for this academic year 2017-2018 as aid is awarded on a first-come, first-served basis.

Students beginning their studies in Spring 2018 must file the 2017-2018 FAFSA. FAFSA's can be completed on the web with a link directly to TAP: [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov). Contact the Financial Aid Office if you have any questions 516.323.4200.
